#Sound system update – the speakers are being installed and should be completed by next Wednesday.

We will need volunteers to help build the building. Several parishioners have already come forward and offered their help.

#The Cluster purchased Stations of the Cross for the Montezuma Retreat Center. Open house at the Retreat Center is June 20 and June 21 from 2 pm until 7pm.

#Outdoor Mass-The mass for the St Henry picnic will be at 4:00 on Saturday. Everyone should bring their own lawn chairs. In the event of inclement weather, the mass will be moved inside the church.
